SPINE-o-SAWR-us

Meaning: Spiny lizard

Food: Meat (Carnivore)

Length: 40-50 feet

Weight: 4 tons or more

Period: Cretaceous period,

Location: Egypt, Morocco, **Africa**



## Ankylosaurus

Ang-KIE-lo-SAWR-us

Meaning: Fused lizard

Food: Plants (Herbivore)

Length: 25-35 feet

Weight: 3-4 tons

Period: Cretaceous period,

Location: Western USA (Montana) and Canada (Alberta), **North America.**



## Stegosaurus

STEG-o-SAWR-us

Meaning: Roof lizard or Plated lizard

Food: Plants (Herbivore)

Length: 26-30 feet

Weight: 6,800 pounds

Period: Jurassic period,

Location: Colorado, Utah, and Wyoming, USA, **North America.**



## Pteranodon

ter-AN-o-DON

Meaning: Winged and toothless

Food: Meat (Carnivore). Ate mostly fish

Wingspan: 25-33 feet

Weight: 55 pounds

Period: Cretaceous period

Location: Kansas, USA, **North America** and in England, **Europe.**



## Velociraptor

vuh-LOSS-ih-RAP-tor

Meaning: Speedy thief  
Food: Meat (Carnivore).  
Length: 5 to 6 feet  
Weight: 15 to 33 pounds  
Period: Cretaceous period  
Location: Mongolia, Russia, and China, **Asia**.



## Triceratops

try-SER-a-tops

Meaning: Three horned face  
Food: Plants (Herbivore).  
Length: 30 feet  
Weight: 6-12 tons  
Period: Cretaceous period  
Location: Western Canada and the western United States, **North America**.



## Corythosaurus

ko-RITH-o-SAWR-us

- Meaning: Helmet lizard  
Food: Plants (Herbivore).  
Length: 30-33 feet  
Weight: About 5 tons  
Period: Cretaceous period  
Location: **North America**, including Montana, USA, and Alberta, Canada.



## Iguanodon

ig-WAHN-oh-don

- Meaning: Iguana tooth  
Food: Plants (Herbivore)  
Length: 20-33 feet  
Weight: About 4-5 tons  
Period: Cretaceous period  
Location: **Europe** (in England, Belgium, and Germany), **Northern Africa**, and the USA, **North America**.



## Diplodocus

di-PLOD-o-kus

Meaning: Double-beamed  
Food: Plants (Herbivore)  
Length: 90 feet  
Weight: About 10-20 tons  
Period: Jurassic period  
Location: Rocky Mountains of the western USA (in Colorado, Montana, Utah, and Wyoming), **North America.**



## Dimetrodon (not a dino)

di-MET-ro-DON

Meaning: Two measures tooth  
Food: Meat (Carnivore)  
Length: 11.5 feet  
Weight: 550 pounds  
Period: Permian period (long before Dinosaurs appeared)  
Location: Texas and Oklahoma in the USA, **North America.** Trackways (fossilized footprints) of Dimetrodon have been found in Nova Scotia, Canada.



## Apatosaurus

a-PAT-o-SAWR-us

Meaning: Deceptive lizard

Food: Plants (Herbivore).  
Apatosaurus swallowed stones to help grind up its tough plant food. It did not chew its food.

Length: 70-90 feet

Weight: 33-38 tons

Period: Jurassic period

Location: Colorado, Oklahoma, Utah, and Wyoming, in the USA, North America.



## Tyrannosaurus

tie-RAN-o-SAWR-us rex

Meaning: Tyrant lizard king

Food: Meat (Carnivore)

Length: 40 feet

Weight: 5 to 7 tons

Period: Cretaceous period

Location: In the USA (in Montana, Texas, Utah, and Wyoming), Canada (Alberta and Saskatchewan), North America and east Asia (Mongolia).
